City of Harker Heights Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2017

The City of Harker Heights purchases natural gas from Atmos Energy. In Calendar Year 2017, the City purchased a total of 9,816 hundred cubic feet (CCF) of natural gas.

The City purchases electricity from Gexa Energy. In Calendar Year 2017, the City purchased a total of 7,715,060 kilowatt hours.

The City also purchases electricity from Bartlett Electric Cooperative. In Calendar Year 2017, the City purchased a total of 0 kilowatt hours and has 100 street lights with them.

The City purchases water from Bell County WCID #1. In Calendar Year 2017, the City purchased a total of 1,561,311,000 gallons of water plus an additional 5,265 acre feet.

The City also purchases water by the acre foot from Brazos River Authority. A total of 3,535 acre feet were purchased in the Calendar Year 2017.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity, and water purchased by the City in the Calendar Year 2017 is \$3,236,549.
