



## **2018 MASTER HOLIDAY COLLECTION SCHEDULE**

### **New Year's Day - Monday, January 1, 2018**

Trash services will run one day late after the holiday through Saturday, January 6th. For example, Monday's routes, will run Tuesday, Tuesday's routes will run Wednesday, etc. All normally scheduled Saturday routes will remain unchanged and will be collected on Saturday. Services will resume their normal schedule the week of January 8<sup>th</sup>.

### **Memorial Day - Monday, May 28, 2018**

Trash services for the week of Memorial Day will run on their normal schedule. Monday routes will run on Monday, Tuesday routes will run on Tuesday, etc.

### **Independence Day - Wednesday, July 4, 2018**

Trash services will run one day late after the holiday through Saturday, July 7. For example, Wednesday routes will run Thursday, Thursday routes will run Friday, etc. All normally scheduled Monday, Tuesday and Saturday routes will remain unchanged and will be collected on their normal days. Services will resume their normal schedule the week of July 9.

### **Labor Day - Monday, September 3, 2018**

Trash services for the week of Labor Day will run on their normal schedule. Monday routes will run on Monday, Tuesday routes will run on Tuesday, etc.

### **Thanksgiving Day - Thursday, November 22, 2018**

Trash routes will run one day late after the holiday through Saturday, November 24. Thursday routes will be collected on Friday, and Friday routes will be collected on Saturday. All normally scheduled Saturday routes will remain unchanged and will be collected on Saturday. Services will resume their normal schedule the week of November 26.

### **Christmas Day - Tuesday, December 25, 2018**

Trash routes will run one day late after the holiday through Saturday, December 29. For example, Tuesday routes will run Wednesday, Wednesday routes will run Thursday, etc. All normally scheduled Saturday routes will remain unchanged and will be collected on Saturday.
