Memorial Day - No delay in service.

Independence Day - No service.

Labor Day - No delay in service.

Thanksgiving Day - Trash collection services will run one day behind AFTER the holiday through Saturday. Waste Management will collect Thursday routes on Friday, and Friday and Saturday routes on Saturday. Services will resume their normal schedule the week after Thanksgiving.

Christmas Day- Routes will run one day ahead of the holiday. For example, Waste Management will collect Saturday routes on Friday.

New Year's Day 2022 - Routes will run one day ahead of the holiday. For example, Waste Management will collect Saturday routes on Friday.

# RESIDENT RECYCLING DROP CENTER - FREE OF CHARGE

Harker Heights residents are entitled to drop off the following items at the Recycling Drop Center located at 1761 FM 2410 (Knights Way).

- » Residents may dispose of 4 cubic yards (approx. the size of a pick-up bed.), at the Recycling Drop Center twice a day.
- » Residents are required to bring a valid ID and most recent City of Harker Heights utility invoice.
- » The free disposal is for residential waste only. Commercial and industrial waste will not be accepted.
- » The Recycling Drop Center will accept the following items Tuesday Saturday 8 AM to 5PM except on holidays. Gate closes at 4:50 PM.

Plastic Scrap metal Aluminum Tires\*


Paper Used cooking oil\*

- \* Tires with or without rims.
- \* No motor oil.
- \* Any appliance that once contained Freon must have a certificate indicating the professional removal of Freon.



## **EXCITING NEWS!**

Starting March 1, 2021, the City of Harker Heights and Waste Management of Texas, Inc. will introduce new, improved trash service in 96-gallon carts. Waste Management will continue to service the City of Harker Heights on the current schedule of twice-a-week pick up for trash.

### **NEW CARTS**

Each resident will receive one NEW 96-gallon cart for items considered trash. The new, larger trash carts can hold up to 175 pounds, enabling residents of Harker Heights to keep their streets and neighborhoods clean.

If you choose to label your new cart, please use number stickers that can be found at home improvement stores. **Do not use paint or markers.** 

## **ADDITIONAL CARTS**

Residents can request additional carts through the City of Harker Heights for an additional \$5.00 a month per cart. To order an additional cart, please contact the City of Harker Heights at 254-953-5649.

## **OLD TRASH CONTAINERS**

Waste Management will collect any old unwanted customer-owned containers in March. Simply place empty container at the curb on your regular collection date, and mark as "Take".

#### **CART PLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS**

Please follow the guidelines below to ensure your cart collection.

- » Place your cart(s) at the point of collection as early as 6 PM the day before collection or no later than 6 AM the day of collection.
- » All trash must be inside the cart(s). Waste Management will not collect trash outside the cart(s).
- » Do not overfill cart(s). Lids must close securely.
- » Place cart(s) 5 feet from obstructions, such as vehicles or mailboxes, and within 1 foot from the curb or fence. Place with the handles facing your home or fence.
- » If you have more than one cart, please space carts 2-3 feet apart.
- » Do not obstruct the collection of cart(s) by parking vehicles in the vicinity.
- » Cart(s) should be removed from the point of collection no later than 12 PM on the day after collection.
